

Welcome to Coble Cottage

Ian and Lorna hope that you enjoy your stay in Coble Cottage, we have endeavoured to make the cottage as comfortable as possible. However, if there is something we can help you with please do not hesitate to call next door.

Items in the cottage have been sourced wherever possible from local craftsmen. Maintenance and repairs are carried out by local tradesmen.

By the very nature of you coming to enjoy your holiday in a traditional fishing village, Mark and Ian (in the summer months only now) fish Monday to Saturday and often start work very early in the morning. During April & May they fish for Sea Trout and other months Crab and Lobster, all of which can be purchased direct and prepared ready to cook if required. On bad weather days they will sometimes carry out boat maintenance on the drive or mend pots/nets in the work-shed.

For your comfort:

An instruction manual is situated by the cooker which contains all the instruction manuals for the cottage. We hope that in the summer you will make use of the bbq, utensils are in the kitchen. After use please clean out and close all the air vents.

A dog basket is situated in the utility room with contains dog throws and old towels for doggies who like to swim. We would appreciate it if you would pick up any excrement left by pets. We have a lot of wild life outside the cottage please keep your doggie under control and on a lead when outside.

The entire garden is available for your use and please feel free to move the outside furniture around to suit wherever you wish to sit.

Domestics:

The bins for the cottage are opposite your car park. Green is for all general refuse and Blue is for recycling its such as plastic bottles, paper, cardboard, tins, drink cans - **PLEASE NO GLASS**

If required, a non-slip shower mat can be found in the bathroom cabinet.

In Alnwick, which is our nearest town we have farm and local shops offering a side range of Northumbrian products, butchers, bakers, banks and building society along with a very well stocked local pet shop in the centre of Alnwick.

For supermarket shopping we have Sainsbury, Lidl, Aldi, Morrisons and a small COOP in Alnwick. If you need directions please ask.

The nearest petrol stations are at the south end of Alnwick and are easily accessed via the south bound A1.

For your safety

Ian and I recognise that a great part of the beauty of staying in Coble Cottage is its unrestricted access to the surrounding garden and beach. We would very much like to keep it this way for everyones enjoyment and we would like to point out the your children and pets are your responsibility and care should be taken to ensure that they are safe at all times.

Therefore, we would like to bring to your attention the following:

- We have a pond situated outside our conservatory which you are welcome to come and look at. However, it is deep, and children should be accompanied at all times and dogs kept under control.
- The beach and rocks are right on the doorstep and a wonderful place for adventures, the sea can come quickly over the rocks and if you are not aware of the tide times you can still be out on the rocks and cut off the beach from the incoming tide, please be watchful.
- Boulmer haven is a safe environment for swimming as there are no under currents. If using inflatables please take care not to allow children to be blown off shore - the nearest RNLI is at Amble and Craster a good 45 - 60 mins away. Other beaches at Longhoughton and Alnmouth have dangerous areas and undercurrents and we do not recommend swimming at those beaches.
- If visiting Lindisfarne please remember that the island is cut off from the main land when the sea comes in. Safe crossing times can be found in local papers, internet and at the beginning on the mainland at the beginning of the cause way.

In the event of a Fire

The smoke/fire alarm cannot be switched off the carbon monoxide alarm has a battery so can be switched off. However, if either alarms goes off there is a high probability that there is a problem with fire or carbon monoxide in the cottage.



Your first priority is to YOURSELF and any others in the cottage,

If you feel the fire is small enough, that it can be easily dealt with there is a fire blanket and extinguisher for electrical fires in the hall.

In the event that the fire is not containable please:

- **Vacate the cottage immediately**
- **If you are able please close all the doors**
- **Contact Ian or Lorna next door**
- **If neither of us are around please call 999**
